Secondary School Admissions

The secondary school admission round opens on Thursday 12th September for parents of current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school place (Year 7) for September 2025. The statutory national closing date for applications is 31st October 2024.

Applications can be made online via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions. All of the application information is available on the website. Parents will not receive letters regarding this, it is your responsibility to log on to the website and make an application before the closing date.



Reminders

<u>School Times</u> - please ensure children are not on school premises before 8.25am and that all children being collected at 3.15pm have left the premises by 3.30pm.

<u>Nut Free School</u> - due to allergies within the school we have a nut free policy, including any chocolate spread that may contain nuts, please be aware of this if your child brings a packed lunch or snacks.
