We have been fully anticipating a visit from Ofsted for a long time and it has been twelve years since Chipping Hill was last inspected. The education inspection framework has undergone significant changes during this time and sixteen versions have been updated, the last being in September 2024. You will probably be aware that there is no longer an overarching judgement given to schools.

I want to praise all of the children and staff for showcasing our school so positively during the inspection and for the hard work that they consistently demonstrate and the dedication they show. Parents and Carers will be sent the Ofsted report in about 6 weeks, once it has been validated and been through a rigorous quality assurance process.

Thank you to those parents who completed the online Ofsted survey and for the positive comments you made. As always, we appreciate your support. It has been a very busy start to what we know is an incredibly full half term.
